




## Pessac Léognan

Situated in the Graves region, Pessac-Léognan is revered for its exceptional red and white wines. The gravelly and sandy soils, combined with a temperate maritime climate, create the perfect conditions for cultivating Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Pessac-Léognan reds are known for their robust structure, while the whites exhibit freshness, minerality, and citrus notes.




## Saint-Émilion

Nestled on the right bank of the Dordogne River, Saint-Émilion is distinguished for its merlot-dominant blends, producing velvety and approachable wines. The region's limestone and clay soils, coupled with a continental climate, create a favorable environment for cultivating Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. Saint-Émilion wines are often characterized by their ripe fruit flavours, supple tannins, and nuances of plum, cherry, and spice.




## Médoc

The Médoc is renowned for its elegant, full-bodied red wines. Nestled between the Gironde estuary and the Atlantic Ocean, this terroir benefits from a moderate oceanic climate and gravelly soil, ideal for growing Bordeaux grape varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The wines of this region are characterized by their pronounced tannic structure and complex aromas of black fruit, blackcurrant and woody notes.


## **Sauternes**

Located in the Graves region, Sauternes is famous for its luscious and opulent sweet wines made from Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle grapes affected by noble rot. The misty mornings along the Garonne River foster the growth of Botrytis cinerea, imparting unique flavors of honey, apricot, and caramel to the wines. Sauternes is renowned for its dessert wines of unparalleled richness and complexity.




## Vineyards with the family



#### Private cruise on the Garonne

Come aboard a wooden "Vedette" boat for a cruise on the Garonne leaving from Bordeaux.

### Along the Wine Route



#### Guided bike ride

Pascale and Arnaud from Ateliers au Château will take you through the vineyards and Châteaux of the Pessac-Léognan AOC. On foot or by bike!

As wine professionals, they will explain viticulture and oenology to you. You will learn how to recognise Merlot from Cabernet Sauvignon and discover the terroirs of Graves. You will meet a winegrower, visit his barrel cellar and taste his fine wines. The tour takes place at Château Couhins Lurton, or at Château La Louvière in the world of Crus Classés.

#### A day in the Arcachon Bay

Famous for its Dune du Pilat, its oyster-farming villages and its beaches, the Arcachon Bay never ceases to amaze visitors in search of nature and exceptional landscapes.

Spend a day in the Arcachon Bay to enjoy the sea air, just 1 hour from Les Sources de Caudalie.

#### Activities in the Arcachon Bay:

- Climb the Dune du Pilat, an exceptional natural monument to admire its breathtaking panorama.
   The Dune du Pilat is the highest sand dune in Europe (106m).
- Visit the winter town of Arcachon and discover its villas, architectural gems from the late 19th century.
   The unique architecture of these villas makes them precious relics of the town's heyday.
- Take a trip on a pinasse, the traditional boat of the bay, to discover Cap Ferret, the Arcachon Bay and its famous "cabanes tchanquées" from the sea. Private cruises from 1 380 euros for half a day. Our pinasse can accommodate up to ll passengers. Available from April to October.
- Relax on the Plage du Moulleau.
- Take a shuttle boat to Cap Ferret from the Port of Arcachon

#### A day in Cap Ferret

Visit the Lège-Cap-Ferret peninsula and its 10 fishing villages for a day.

Between the bay and the ocean, nature awaits you.

#### Activities in Cap Ferret:

- Walk along the "boulevard de la Plage".
- Beaches on the Bay side: "Plage des Américains" or "Plage du Centre" and beach on the Ocean side: "Plage de L'horizon".
- Enjoy a panoramic view of the peninsula from the Cap Ferret lighthouse, a listed historic monument.
- Visit the chapel of the Villa Algérienne named Sainte Marie du Cap. This Moorish-inspired building was built in 1885.
- Take a trip on a pinasse, the traditional boat of the Bay, to discover Cap Ferret, the Arcachon Bay and its famous "cabanes tchanquées" from the sea. Private cruises from 1 380 euros for half a day. OU pinasse can accommodate up to ll passengers. Available from April to October.
- Take a shuttle boat to Arcachon.
- Visit the villages and stop off at a fisherman's hut for oysters.



#### A day in Bordeaux

Bordeaux is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a must-see.

Allow 25 minutes by car from Les Sources de Caudalie.

#### Not to be missed:

- Saint-Pierre and Saint-Paul, the city's oldest districts, with their medieval gates (La Grosse Cloche and La Porte Cailhau) and narrow cobbled streets.
- Place de la Bourse and its famous water mirror.
- Place de la Comédie with its Grand Théâtre.
- Saint-André Cathedral and Pey-Berland Tower.
- Les Chartrons, a former wine merchant's quarter, now famous for its second-hand goods and antiques.
- Shopping on rue Sainte-Catherine, rue des Remparts, cours de l'Intendance and the little streets of the Saint-Pierre district (rue du Pas-Saint-Georges, rue Saint-James).
- Discover the immersive exhibitions at the Bassin des Lumières.
- Taste cannelés, Bordeaux's speciality pastry, at Baillardran or La Toque Cuivrée.
- Enjoy a glass of wine in one of the city's many wine bars.
- The Cité du Vin.

#### **The Water Mirror**

Landscape architect Michel Corajoud designed the water mirror to reflect Bordeaux's superb Place de la Bourse on a fine expanse of water.

The water disappears every 10 minutes, giving way to an ephemeral fog (from late March to mid-November) that is particularly popular with children.



#### Le Bassin des Lumières

The world's largest digital art centre is located in the first four cells of the Bordeaux submarine base.

It features monumental immersive digital exhibitions dedicated to the great artists of art history and contemporary creation.




#### The Cité du Vin
