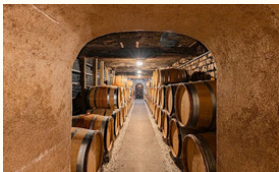
Armelle et Bernard Rion Domain

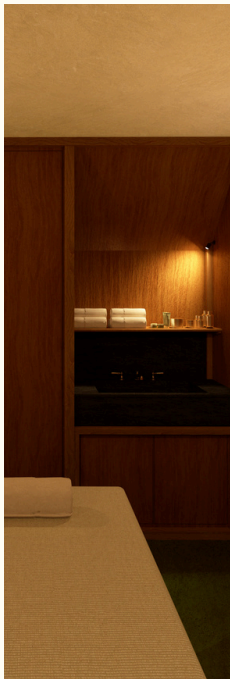

Municipal Museum

Château du Clos de Vougeot

2 minutes by car - Vougeot

Le Château de Savigny-lès-Beaune

30 minutes by car

The Château de Savigny-lès-Beaune offers a unique visit combining historical heritage, vineyards and remarkable mechanical collections, just a short distance from Beaune.

This 14th-century château, listed as a historic monument, houses several museums dedicated to exceptional private collections. Visitors can discover an impressive display of fighter aircraft exhibited in the grounds, as well as Abarth racing cars, vintage motorcycles, fire engines, winemaking equipment and thousands of scale models. The château's wine estate is also open for tastings and sales of Burgundy wines.

Blending medieval architecture, a passion for mechanics and wine culture, the Château de Savigny-lès-Beaune offers a distinctive experience, accessible to all, at the heart of the Burgundian art of living.

Gevrey-Chambertin

Markets

Nuits-Saint-Georges Market

Covered market - Rue Thurot

Every Friday morning, visit the covered market of Nuits-Saint-Georges. You will find a wide selection of fresh produce and regional specialities, including fruit and vegetables, cheeses, cold meats, butcher's produce, bakery items, honey, prepared dishes, flowers and seafood. Around sixty traders are present throughout the year, making it a key part of local life. A smaller market also takes place on Tuesday mornings.

Around Vougeot

Hidden Treasures and Burgundian Châteaux

It is impossible to stay in Vougeot without visiting the Château du Clos de Vougeot, a symbol of the region's wine heritage and an emblematic site of the Confrérie des Chevaliers du Tastevin. It is located just a short distance from the hotel.

A getaway in the surrounding area reveals a heritage that is both diverse and unexpected. The Château de Savigny-lès-Beaune, set among vineyards, houses remarkable collections of aircraft, motorcycles and vintage cars. Further north, the Château de Commarin, still owned by the same family since the 12th century, perfectly illustrates the history of Burgundy's great families. The wine villages of Gevrey-Chambertin and Nuits-Saint-Georges, with their Romanesque churches and winegrowers' houses, complete this immersion into an authentic and timeless Burgundy.



The Monks' Walk



The Abbey Trail

Blending nature and spirituality, the Monks' Walk invites you to step back in time. This trail connects Vougeot to the prestigious Abbaye de Cîteaux, cradle of the Cistercian order founded in the 12th century. The monks once shaped the landscape here, planted the first vines of the Clos de Vougeot and sculpted the surrounding valleys.

As you walk, the path follows the same routes once taken by the monks, winding through vineyard slopes and open farmland. Stretching around twelve kilometres round trip, the trail passes through forests, meadows and country paths, in a peaceful and contemplative atmosphere.

At the end of the walk, the Abbaye de Cîteaux reveals its sober and majestic architecture, a testament to medieval monastic craftsmanship. Visitors can discover the daily life of the monks, the monastic bookshop and the famous Cîteaux cheese, still produced on site.

Accessible to all, this half-day walk combines cultural discovery with a sense of renewal. It offers a soothing and inspiring experience, linking the history of wine with that of spirituality in Burgundy.

A Medieval and Wine Heritage Jewel

The capital of Burgundy wines, Beaune enchants with its authenticity and the beauty of its landmarks.

Its famous Hospices de Beaune, founded in the 15th century, were once a hospital for the most vulnerable. Today, they house an exceptional museum retracing the history of charity and medicine through the centuries. Their colourful glazed tile roof has become one of Burgundy's most iconic symbols. Every third Sunday in November, the Hospices also host the world's oldest wine auction, a prestigious charitable event celebrating Burgundy's winemaking expertise.

The town reveals a charming historic centre, lined with ramparts, cobbled streets and period buildings. The Basilica of Notre-Dame, the belfry and the Maison des Climats further enrich this journey through history, where medieval heritage meets a wine culture recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Capital of the Dukes of Burgundy

A city of art and history, Dijon captivates with its elegance and the richness of its heritage. The impressive Palace of the Dukes of Burgundy, a jewel of the historic centre, now houses the Museum of Fine Arts, one of the oldest and most distinguished museums in France.

Nearby, the Museum of the History of Dijon traces the city's evolution from the Middle Ages to the modern era.

The Cité Internationale de la Gastronomie et du Vin, located in the former general hospital, celebrates the French art of living and the culinary richness of Burgundy. Dijon appeals equally to history enthusiasts and lovers of gastronomy.

The Owl Trail in Dijon

For a city escape, the Owl Trail in Dijon is ideal. This walking route lasts around 1 hour 30 minutes to 2 hours (approximately 3 km) and is divided into 22 stages, allowing visitors to discover the main landmarks and curiosities of the historic centre.

The path is marked by arrows and small owl-shaped plaques, guiding visitors past the Palace of the Dukes, the cathedral, the Town Hall, the Well of Moses and the Darcy Garden. A wonderful way to combine heritage, history and an urban stroll.

Walks in Burgundy



Along the Vouge River and Through the Vineyards

The Vouge walk highlights the river La Vouge, which winds through vineyard landscapes before reaching the plains. As it passes through the grounds of Les Sources de Vougeot, it offers visitors a peaceful atmosphere, shaped by the gentle murmur of the water and the freshness of the riverbanks. The route partly follows the course of the river, revealing its tributaries, former mills, bridges and wooded areas. Ideal for a nature outing from the hotel, this walk is appreciated for its tranquillity and its close connection with the surrounding environment.

The circuit around Vougeot showcases the wine heritage and iconic landscapes of the Clos de Vougeot. The route winds through the vineyards and offers superb views of the château as well as the hillsides listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Approximately 8.5 km in length, this accessible loop alternates between vineyard paths and shaded woodland trails. It invites you to admire the geometry of the plots, appreciate the richness of the terroirs and contemplate the Clos from different perspectives, between history and nature.

Crossing the Vineyards

The Route des Grands Crus

For a more panoramic outing, the Route des Grands Crus, between Dijon and Beaune, offers an emblematic journey through Burgundy's vineyards over approximately sixty kilometres. This legendary route connects prestigious villages such as Vosne-Romanée, Meursault, Nuits-Saint-Georges and Pommard.

It can be explored by bike for cycling enthusiasts or by car, stopping at points of interest, in cellars or at viewpoints offering superb panoramas over the hillsides. It is also possible to combine this discovery with short walks through the vineyard slopes.

A walking alternative, the "Grands Crus Walk", offers a nine-kilometre route linking Vougeot to Vosne-Romanée. This path crosses legendary vineyard plots and is punctuated with information panels to better understand the richness and diversity of the terroirs.
